

KinderKamp – Summer 2011

KinderKamp is a youth day camp offered for children entering or continuing Kindergarten in the fall. This camp is designed to provide a safe, challenging, and creative environment for campers through programmed activities. Activities each week include arts and crafts, games, songs, water play, special events, and field trips. Field trips will be on Wednesdays with special events on Fridays.

Dates: Weekly sessions, June 23 through August 18, Monday through Friday
*** Please Note: There is no camp on Friday, August 19, due to overnighter.**

Price: \$134 per session for residents - \$144 per session for non residents
Check with the Recreation office for drop-in prices and availability.

Hours: 9:00am - 2:00pm – Some Wednesday field trips will result in late arrival and we may extend camp to 4:30

Location: Skylandia Park, Lake Forest – Drop-off and pick-up at parking lot at corner of Lake Forest and Aspen.

Signing In/Out: Parents must check in/out their children each day with their individual counselor. At no time should a child leave without first notifying a counselor. Please send a note if your child is to be picked up by anyone other than a parent. Camp ends at 2:00pm. (Except otherwise noted). A \$1 fee will be charged for every minute you are late picking up your child.

Food: Please send a BIG, nourishing lunch every day. Make sure your child's name is on the lunch. Also, a bottle of water helps a lot! In an effort to help teach environmental awareness, we ask that you try to pack a lunch that will result in as little litter or waste as possible.

Clothing: Each child must wear closed toe shoes and socks (no sandals), and should bring a swimsuit and towel daily. It is best if campers wear their swimsuits under their clothes. All personal items should be labeled. Sunscreen, hat and flip flops or water shoes for beach time are always a good idea! (It is best if sunscreen is applied at home.) Staff will encourage children to reapply sunscreen throughout the day, but we will not apply for them.

Rain: During short thundershowers, we will do our best to shelter the children. However, due to a lack of indoor facilities, camp will be canceled if it is raining hard. If in doubt, call the Parks and Recreation office after 8am, or pick them up.

Field Trips: Your child's enrollment in camp is his or her ticket to weekly field trips. Your transportation fees have been included with your initial registration. All trips are via TCPUD Vans or TTUSD bus.

Overnighter: Our all-camp overnighter is scheduled for Thursday, August 11. It begins at 7pm and will end Friday, August 12 at 9am sharp. Campers should have dinner prior to attending. Children must be signed up for the entire last session to attend the overnighter. No drop-ins will be allowed.
