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**Please be aware of the following requirements:**

1. All water and sewer lines must be constructed of a material approved by the District.
2. The District must inspect all new line installations, including the trench prior to backfill.
3. An air test of the sewer line is required when ANY modification is made to the sewer. This includes construction OVER an existing line. All air tests must be witnessed by the District.
4. All fixtures must be low flow, and cannot exceed the following:  
Toilets - 1.6 gallons per flush; Showers - 2.5 gallons per minute; Faucets - 2.2 gallons per minute
5. Water pressure must not exceed 60 psi
6. Backflow prevention assemblies are required on potentially hazardous services. The assemblies are the property of and maintained by the owner. They must be tested by a District approved tester upon installation and annually thereafter.
7. The District must make a final inspection of fixtures and water pressure prior to the final County inspection. All fixtures must be set prior to inspection.
8. There must be ten feet of horizontal separation between water and sewer lines or water shall be 1 foot above and 1 foot horizontal from sewer.
