## ORDINANCE NO. 294 OF TAHOE CITY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT AMENDING AND MODIFYING ORDINANCE NO. 255 (AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBERS 290, 257, 259-A, 261-A, 266, 268, 270, 272, 278 and 287) EXHIBIT 10.01 SEWER CONNECTION FEES, USER FEES AND SERVICE FEES

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has analyzed and considered the costs and expenses projected for operation of District sewer systems and capital improvements to facilities for the 2018 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, District must establish and collect service fees in order to meet the anticipated operational and administrative costs of District sewer systems and capital improvements to facilities; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted rates on November 17, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors determines that, notwithstanding the need to implement revised sewer rates and charges, the state of the economy and its present effect on the finances of District customers should be considered. The Board has been provided data from staff that shows rate revenue available for capital is projected to be below the adopted 2014 HDR Rate Study adopted rate study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TAHOE CITY PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT as follows:

**SECTION 1**: FINDINGS. After considering the facts offered, and duly deliberating the matters presented, the Board of Directors of Tahoe City Public Utility District finds and determines that:

- A. The above recitals are true.
- B. The Board is empowered to prescribe, revise, and collect fees and charges to operate and maintain the District's sewer system.
- C. The rates and charges set forth in the attached schedule are not discriminatory; and,
- D. The rates and charges set forth in the attached schedule are not excessive inasmuch as revenues from said rates and charges will not exceed the costs of providing sewer service.

**SECTION 2**: SEWER RATES AND CHARGES. Based upon these findings, the Board approves and directs the implementation of sewer rates and charges for the year 2018 as set forth in Exhibit 10.01 to this Resolution.

A. Exhibit 10.01 of Ordinance No. 255 (as amended by Ordinance Numbers 290, 257, 259-A, 261-A, 266, 268, 270, 272, 278 and 287), Rate Codes 201 through 399, is modified as shown on Exhibit 10.01 to this Ordinance 294 in order to implement revised sewer rates adopted by the Board on November 17, 2017. The rates previously set in Exhibit 10.01 of Ordinance No. 255 shall take effect on January 1, 2018 unless the District revises the rates further.

B. Except as modified and amended hereby (and by Ordinance Numbers 290, 257, 259-A, 261-A, 266, 268, 270, 272, 278 and 287), Ordinance No. 255 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3**: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance is effective upon its adoption. This Ordinance and the amendments and modifications hereby made, shall become effective 30 days from the date of its enactment and prior thereto shall be posted and published as required by law. The sewer rates will be applied with the first billing period beginning on or after January 1, 2018.

**SECTION 4**: REVISED IMPLEMENTATION OF SEWER RATE. Annually, the Board will review the operating expenses, the capital costs, and the revenues received as compared to the projections used in HDR's

Water and Sewer Comprehensive Rate Study. The Board will then determine if the rates for the coming year should be modified based on revised conditions in order to maintain continuity with the adopted study. The Board may reduce the rates in any given year, but cannot exceed the cumulative rates presented for any specific year to the ratepayers through the Proposition 218 process.
